Frequently Asked Questions



∞ Who is developing Woolbrae?

Woolbrae is being developed by Kaha Ake. Classic Developments has been engaged to manage the delivery of the project.

∞ When are titles due?

Building of some homes will begin around mid-2025 on completion of 224. Titles are expected to be issued in early 2026, ready for occupancy.

∞ Can I buy a section, and design my own home?

Sections are not for sale. Homes will be available to purchase as House & Land Packages through our Build Partners.

∞ What amenities will Woolbrae offer?

Woolbrae will include a playground suitable for all ages and scenic walking paths. Once completed, a proposed cycleway will connect Jacks Point, Woolbrae, and Frankton. Woolbrae is also close to the emerging Jacks Point Village with shops, restaurants, and recreational facilities.

∞ What Schools is Woolbrae zoned for?

- Te Kura Whakatipu o Kawerau (Hanleys Farm School): A full primary school (Year 1–8), co-educational.
- Wakatipu High School: The designated secondary school for the wider Queenstown area, including Jacks Point residents.

∞ Do I pay rates to Queenstown Lakes District Council (QLDC)?

Yes, as a residential property owner in the district, you will pay rates to QLDC.

∞ Can I rent out my home?

Yes, provided you comply with all relevant requirements under the district plan. Owners must ensure tenants follow bylaws and maintain the property and landscaping.

∞ How do I get my mail delivered?

NZ Post does not deliver mail directly to Woolbrae due to the absence of a postcode. You can set up a PO Box at the Wakatipu Post Office in Frankton or Queenstown.

∞ Can I have pets at Woolbrae?

Yes, domestic cats and dogs are allowed, provided they comply with local council bylaws.

∞ Will there be a resident's association?

No.

∞ Will there be additional parking along the street?

Each home will have a minimum of two off street carparks, including garage space. There will also be some carparks available on the street.

∞ How do I get to Woolbrae?

Currently access to Woolbrae is through Hanley's Farm via Jack Hanley Drive. In the future, a new northern connection is planned.
